We do not know what this means, but we pray that God will grant the leadership of Ukraine wisdom concerning the crisis that the country is currently in. Space does not afford us the opportunity to write about everything going on here regarding the government, new laws that are being passed, and regional decisions that are being made, but *we ask that you keep us in your prayers.*
