I found out that both countries have shut down their borders until September. They are not even issuing student visas at this time! I may have to obtain a short tourist visa and make my visit to Belarus which has been much more lenient on Covid-19 restrictions. God is able! We petition you for your prayers.

During this month, we were able to meet with another family who has a child had sagittal craniosynostosis, like Jack does. They were definitely an encouragement and helped us know what to expect regarding surgery and recovery.

Please continue to pray for those we have previously mentioned. Pray for Zhenya the Russian Orthodox priest that I have been witnessing to. The constant placement of tradition over Scripture never ceases to amaze me. These conversations have been beneficial for me too as it has taught me much about the existing stumbling blocks to faith in Russia and Ukraine. After talking to Zhenya, I know that I will be even more ready for the next Russian Orthodox adherent that we meet.
