## Update from Ukraine

This is a very important time in Ukraine right now! And we get to be here. On Sunday, March 31st, the first round of the Presidential elections took place. So much hinges, it seems, on which candidate is chosen. How will Ukraine's relationship with Russia and the United States improve or worsen? How will the laws concerning religious liberty change, if at all?

One of the noteworthy incidents this month was an attempted bombing in the city's subway system by someone whom authorities claim was acting on behalf of a nearby government. Who knows how many would have been killed if he had been successful. There is suspicion that he is not alone. Thank you to all who have been faithfully praying for us! We do not want to think about what might happen if people stop praying.

Nonetheless, we have continued as best we can to remain busy doing the Lord's work here in Eastern Ukraine. We have taken every opportunity given us to participate in the ministries of the local church here. I have been able to verbally witness to people that I have met. One was the lady who cut my hair [risky, I know!] and another was a young man that I asked to help me translate a paper I have been writing for an upcoming event. In three pages the text include many of the Biblical references talking about Christ as the passover lamb, sacrificial lamb, and "Lamb of God." At the end of reading through it, he had some awesome questions which turned into a conversation that lasted after the cafe we were sitting in closed. Pray for him. He is an atheist named Igor.

Earlier this month Katrina was able to exchange phone numbers with another mother and they plan to meet once school is out. English is a tool that we can use, but ultimately it is to then introduce them to the Gospel. We are excited about what God has done this month, and what He will do next month. So much has been planned - pray with us!
