God desires that each soul in the Russian Federation be saved and that cannot be accomplished until there are enough people praying, going, and sending. We are sent from our local church in Greenville, Pennsylvania to reach across the Atlantic to a people with a foreign culture and who are foreign to salvation by grace through faith. We are going as ambassadors for our Lord. We wish to offer you a part in the incredible task at hand of fulfilling the Great Commission in the Russian Federation. But before investing in God's work, you should know a little about us.

We are both graduates from Heartland Baptist Bible College where I have received a Bachelors degree in Biblical Studies (majoring in both Pastoral and in Missions) and she a Bachelors degree in Elementary Education (with a minor in Music). My wife and I both have attended some language school already both before and after our first term. We also spent time working underneath a well-seasoned, already-established missionary named John O'Brien.
