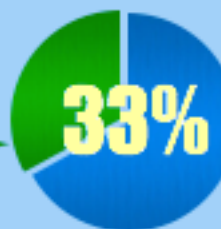
Woman Warrior. As an early Valentine's Day gift, Katrina was able to go to a special women-oriented self-defense class, teaching basic self-defense.
